The CSR settlement has inevitably required us to look hard at all our areas of expenditure, especially those in the non-programme areas, in order to ensure that we have sufficient funds to make the progress we need in the core activities of decommissioning and waste management.

nfortunately, this has led to some speculation that the NDA was pulling out of the NNA ogether or that we might chose to build the NNA somewhere other than Wick. I can assure u that no such decisions have been made.

we discussed, we remain committed to building an archive in Wick, however the scope of at project and the timing of its delivery are under review. When we have completed that view I will be in touch to update you of our revised plans.

the meantime, we will continue to work in partnership with the key organisations in the gion to progress other important and exciting socio-economic developments.
