

Decommissioning Commitments



- Deliver the Client Specification
 - A 200 page document that defines what Dounreay has to deliver
 - Can be changed with a Change Control
- Comply with requirements on H&S, procurement, etc.
- Achieve Interim End State by 14 Sep 2023
- Deliver for Target price of £1.6Bn
- Particle monitoring
 - Provide plans for utilities etc. to get from Interim End State to Final End State (2333)



Interim End State



- Achieve Interim End State
 - Contamination levels left in-situ should allow the "no danger" threshold to be met for delicensing at Final End State
 - All material stored on site to be removed
 - All structures demolished to plinth level
 - Except on the map over or where a business case is made to retain building
 - Site drains, services and roads left in-situ, subject to environmental safety case
 - Soft landscaping
 - Fuel to be left on site
 - But is subject to change





Socio-Economics – our commitments for both SLC and PBO



- Land & Property
 - If there is potential for reuse prioritise for spin-offs, then engage with CNSRP and the Chamber of Commerce
- Socio-Economics
 - 8 Topics (next slide)
- Stakeholder Engagement
 - Engage where appropriate, comply with NDA strategy, develop an NDA/SLC/PBO comms protocol, maintain website and support the Dounreay Stakeholder Group



SLC SE Commitments in the bid



- Comply with NDA Policy
- Maintain existing Socio-Economic Commitments
- Produce an annual 3 year socio-economic plan
- Discuss the plan with stakeholders
- Support the CNSRP
- Partnering Agreement/Charter
- Release staffing profiles to aid planning
- Honour the commitment to the Caithness and North Sutherland Fund (LLW)

PBO Commitments in the bid



- Utilise our experience and engage with all agencies
- Review staff forecast data
- Encourage local businesses, provide experts, leverage our contacts
- Support and encourage SLC spin-offs
- Back-office support and remote services provision
- Multiple initiatives to aid workforce transition
- Ensure SLC compliance with its commitments



How did this translate into requirements in our contracts?



- The SLC is to produce a socio-economic plan
 - And consult with stakeholders
- To support the NDA's strategy
 - And comply with NDA's policies
- Fund £500k/annum to support current socio-economic activities
- Support CNSRP
- Inform the NDA of staffing profile for the site
 - And assist the transition of the workforce into other industries
- Comply with operating agreement between NDA, DSRL and Caithness and North Sutherland Fund
 - in relation to community benefit package for operation of LLW disposal facility
- Encourage local business development opportunities
- Support the spin-out from SLC of parts of existing portfolio of services
- Support the creation of back-office industry in the Caithness and North Sutherland area

So what are we going to do to meet and exceed our contract commitments and bid promises?



- 1. Spin off of nuclear decommissioning related activities
- 2. Understand where our nuclear skills may be viable in non-nuclear decommissioning market and begin trading in this area
- Understand the potential for advance manufacturing development in Caithness & North Sutherland
- 4. Spin off of high value added back office activities
- 5. Produce business plans for niche SMEs in selected markets in creative industries
- 6. Support to renewable energy development
 - Recent Vattenfall/Babcock/Abengoa JV "Nautimus" for wave power and tidal stream EPC
- 7. Examine one-off opportunities as these become apparent
- 8. Work with CNSRP, NDA, other agencies
 - Develop the Dounreay Socio-Economic Board
 - Publish a socio-economic plan
