NB: DSG is a member of the Caithness Transport Forum which is chaired and administered by the Caithness Chamber of Commerce. At the meeting held on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> December the Highland Council announced their Planning and Building Control Service will be holding Charrettes for both Wick and Thurso in February 2013. A charrette is a type of public consultation where the public can voice their opinion on future land use, amongst other issues. Suggestions are marked onto large scale plans and are then reviewed to form the part of the next Local Plan. This will be used to determine planning applications.
