DOUNREAY STAKEHOLDER GROUP KEY HIGHLIGHTS FROM MEETING HELD ON 18TH JUNE 2014

- The minutes of the last meeting were endorsed see <u>DSG(2014)M001</u>.
- A presentation on DFR reactor decommissioning was provided. See <u>DSG(2014)C043</u>.
- The re-profiling of the decommissioning plan continues with agreement to pursue one option (known as Scenario B) now being taken forward. A detailed presentation will be provided to the December DSG.
- Scottish Government will be publishing a consultation document on higher activity waste implementation in the near future.
- The National Audit Office had carried out a major project review concentrating on the NDA's site facing team and how they manage the Dounreay contract. The report has just been received and the outcomes had been positive.
- The NDA had recently purchased Sandside beach. Signage is currently being reviewed.
- The National Nuclear Archives continues to make progress. Four potential commercial partners have now been identified and a meeting has been held with Highland Council relating to land transfer and end user agreements.
- At Vulcan, consideration had been given as to whether to continue to operate the STF until late 2015 or shutdown earlier to look at the reactor core. The conclusion was to continue to operate the STF until 2015. The shutdown period is now complete and critical operations will commence in the next few weeks.
- CoRWM (<u>Committee on Radioactive Waste Management</u>) would be visiting Dounreay on 1st and 2nd of July. A public meeting would be held on 1st July in the Park Hotel, Thurso.
