

Dounreay Heritage Project

Quarterly Report

October – December 2014

1. The DMTR Control Room panels and desk were delivered and installed by DSRL staff for display within Caithness Horizons.
2. A draft Memorandum of Understanding for the proposed joint acquisition of the DFR Control Room was received from The Science Museum and National Museums of Scotland for comment by DSRL and NDA. Minor comments have been received and are being reviewed.
3. History reports for 15 previously demolished buildings were compiled.
4. One heritage object was collected. [Fire Brigade badge.]
5. The small display of heritage objects in Dounreay building D1300 was packaged up and stored away as the room was required as an office. A suitable on-site location is pending.
6. Numerous copies of old Dounreay newsletters, newspapers and magazines were donated to the Caithness Archive Centre in Wick.
7. The International Committee for the Conservation of the Industrial Heritage (TICCIH) accepted a conference paper abstract for their 2015 International Congress. The abstract was jointly written by DSRL and Caithness Horizons and was entitled “The Dounreay Heritage Partnership Project – An innovative approach to developing successful museum partnership working activities.”
