DSG(2015)M004/A004: Nigel Lowe to provide the expected time for the transport of exotic fuel

The Credible Options paper for Exotic Fuels and Nuclear Materials, February 2012, identified as a guide that transport of exotics would be likely to take a 6 year period.

The first move took place in 2015.

We understand that stakeholders may wish to have further detail. However, in the interests of the security of the material, detail of transport routes, timings and transport mode cannot be given.

(The Anti-terrorism, Crime and Security Act 2001, Section 79, explicitly prohibits disclosures which may prejudice the security of nuclear material. This applies to nuclear material held on any nuclear site or material anywhere in the world being transported to or from a nuclear site or on a British ship, or material expected to be so held or transported. Penalties are up to 7 years imprisonment and an unlimited fine.)
